



SLOPE ACCEPTABLE USE POLICY

This Slope Acceptable Use Policy (this “**AUP**” or this “**Policy**”) sets forth certain restrictions on accessing and using Slope Software, Inc.’s and its affiliates’ (collectively, “**Slope**”, “**We**”, “**Our**” or “**Us**”) products and services, including Slope’s software-as-a-service offering, and any equipment (including servers or networks) used in connection therewith (collectively, “**Offerings**”) by you or someone on your behalf (“**You**” or “**Your**”) under your agreement with Slope for such Offerings (“**Agreement**”). The restrictions set forth in this AUP are not exhaustive. This AUP is in addition to the Agreement and any other terms and conditions Slope provides with respect to the Offerings. By using the Offerings, You acknowledge that You have read, understood and agree to abide by this Policy. In addition, You acknowledge that You will be responsible for violations of this AUP by third parties that have gained access to the Offerings through You. If You violate this AUP or authorize or help others to do so, we may suspend or terminate your use of the Offerings and/or Service.

The examples listed in this Policy are not exhaustive. Prohibited uses and activities include, without limitation, any use of the Offerings in a manner that, in Slope’s reasonable judgment, involves, facilitates, or attempts any of the following:

1. to violate any law of, or commit conduct that is tortious or unlawful in, any applicable jurisdiction;
2. to store, transmit, or make available (a) content that is infringing, libelous, unlawful, tortious, or in violation of third-party rights, (b) content or technology that harms, interferes with, or limits the normal operation of the Offerings, including monitoring traffic or data, or (c) viruses, malware, or other malicious code;
3. for illegal, threatening, or offensive uses, or for similarly objectionable purposes, such as propagating hate or violence or causing harm to others or to Our reputation;
4. to transact in, or facilitate activities related to, misappropriating another individual’s identity, including, but not limited to, improperly obtained credit card information and/or account credentials;
5. to attempt to gain unauthorized access to any Offerings or any related systems, including those of Slope’s subcontractors and other customers or users;
6. to permit direct or indirect access to or use of any Offerings in a way that violates the Agreement or use any Offerings to access or use any intellectual property in or related to the Offerings except as permitted under the Agreement;
7. to copy the Offerings, or any part, feature, function or user interface thereof except as expressly allowed under the Agreement; or
8. in order to benchmark Offerings or to build similar or competitive products or services.

You agree to cooperate with appropriate law enforcement agencies and other parties involved in investigating claims of illegal or inappropriate activity. If You become aware of any violation of this Policy by any person, including third parties that have accessed the Offerings through them, You shall inform Us without undue delay.

The terms and conditions of this AUP are hereby incorporated into the Agreement. Any capitalized terms used but not defined herein shall have the meaning set forth in the Agreement or the Documentation, as applicable. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the Agreement, in the event of any conflict between the Agreement and this AUP, the Agreement shall govern. This AUP may be updated by Slope from time to time upon reasonable notice (which may be provided through the Service or by posting an updated version of this AUP).
